### Communication and Language

Ask questions and make relevant comments.  
Express feeling and ideas confidently.  
Hold a conversation with friends and familiar adults.

### Personal, Social & Emotional

Show resilience in the face of challenge.  
Be emphatic towards others.  
Share with others, being kind and considerate.  
Show curiosity about the world around them.

### Physical

Hold a pencil effectively, using it to form recognisable letters.  
Ride a two wheeled bike.  
Confidently use cutlery when eating.  
Know that exercise and activity helps them to be healthy.



### Literacy

Retell familiar stories through play.  
Write simple sentences that can be read by themselves and others.  
Read simple sentences containing phase 2 and 3 phonic sounds.

To count and recognise numbers to 10.  
A deep understand of numbers to 10; including numberbonds and being able to subitise.  
Compare quantities of objects in different contexts.

### Understanding the World

Showing care and concern for living things.  
Know their own family tree.  
Have an appreciation of different beliefs, celebrations and cultural communities.

### Expressive Arts and Design

Create paintings and drawings to represent objects and people.  
Perform stories and songs to an audience.  
Create simple rhythms.
