QUALITY OF EDUCATION

Priority - To offer additional 'catch-up' provision for identified pupils.

Rationale – Pupils having been away from school for an extended period over the past twelve months as a result of the coronavirus pandemic, have incurred lost learning.

Success criteria – By the end of the Academic year, those identified for additional 'catch-up' provision, will have closed the gap on the lost learning

To carry out baseline assessments for all pupils for reading, writing and maths at the end of the Summer Term. End of year targets are created based on these baseline assessments.
